tive or six older, soft towels
Five or six older, soft face clothes or a towel cut up, in a separate bag
Two large plastic sheets (shower curtains or drape cloths)
Two large clean bowls - one for the placenta and the other for water, ice etc.
Extra pillows (at least four) with clean pillow cases
Wash cloths for wiping face in labour
Space heater to boost room temperature for baby's arrival (if needed)
Clean towels and soap in the bathroom
One roll of paper towels
One roll of toilet paper or one box of tissue
An accurate clock
Clean baby clothes, diaper and receiving blanket, baby hat
Cotton tip swabs
Celsius thermometer
Eight to twelve receiving blankets
Small bag of frozen vegetable or crushed ice (for ice packs)
Garbage bags (one for laundry, one for garbage)
Box of table salt (for laundry)

Prepare the bed in layers:

- 1) Mattress
- 2) Plastic cover
- 3) Fresh sheet
- 4) Plastic cover
- 5) Old sheet

Nice things to have around for the birth is you choose:

- I) Massage oil
- 2) Gentle music
- 3) Hot water bottle or heating pad
- 4) Thick flannel sheet for after the birth
